1 At the end of title III, add the following:

2 **SEC. 3\_\_\_. SPENDING-NEUTRAL RESERVE FUND TO PRO-**  
3 **HIBIT THE RECLASSIFICATION OF**  
4 **BROADBAND PROVIDERS AS COMMON CAR-**  
5 **RIERS UNDER TITLE II OF THE COMMUNICA-**  
6 **TIONS ACT OF 1934.**

7 The Chairman of the Committee on the Budget of  
8 the Senate may revise the allocations of a committee or

1 committees, aggregates, and other appropriate levels in  
2 this resolution for one or more bills, joint resolutions,  
3 amendments, amendments between the Houses, motions,  
4 or conference reports relating to the openness of the Inter-  
5 net, which may include prohibiting the reclassification of  
6 broadband providers as common carriers, by the amounts  
7 provided in such legislation for those purposes, provided  
8 that such legislation would not raise new revenue and  
9 would not increase the deficit over either the period of the  
10 total of fiscal years 2016 through 2020 or the period of  
11 the total of fiscal years 2016 through 2025.
