**A BILL**

To prohibit the Federal Communications Commission from reclassifying broadband Internet access service as a telecommunications service and from imposing certain regulations on providers of such service.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Restoring Internet  
5 Freedom Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON AUTHORITY OF FCC.**

7       (a) IN GENERAL.—The rule adopted by the Federal  
8       Communications Commission in GN Docket No. 14–28 on

1 February 26, 2015 (relating to broadband Internet access  
2 service) shall have no force or effect, and the Commission  
3 may not reissue such rule in substantially the same form,  
4 or issue a new rule that is substantially the same as such  
5 rule, unless the reissued or new rule is specifically author-  
6 ized by a law enacted after the date of enactment of this  
7 Act.

8 (b) **RULE DEFINED.**—In this section, the term  
9 “rule” has the meaning given the term in section 804 of  
10 title 5, United States Code.
