The purpose of this modification is to:

Change our target audience and congressional districts from "statewide" to "nationwide." The major focus of our outreach work was to California unions and employers. However, we worked with the Center for Construction Research and Training to promote our trainings to their trainer lists. This resulted in trainers from Illinois and Nevada taking our Train-the-Trainer class and, consequently doing their second-tier training in those states.


